M5 East Expansion: KJA and PB form joint venture

The RTA is investigating the expansion of one of Sydney's major transport corridors: the M5. The aim is to increase accessibility providing an integrated transport solution for commercial areas in the Sydney airport/port precinct and the South West. The proposed M5 expansion is expected to result in approximately \$6 billion of travel time savings over a 30 year period.

The eastern end of the M5 corridor is being explored in a particularly complex political and environmental context. The RTA has chosen a joint venture between KJA and Parsons Brinckerhoff (PB) for the communications delivery from an open tender process. By engaging stakeholders from the community and government sectors, PB/KJA will provide an overarching strategy to manage any issues on this major infrastructure project.
